





SELLING MERCHANDISE FOR BBC CHILDREN IN NEED







## Find out the best way to sell BBC Children in Need merchandise on ParentPay.

#### Here's how:

When setting up a repeatable fixed amount for a regular payment item, the item remains on the payment screen so payers can purchase multiple times if required.

#### Here's a quick example:

- BBC Children in Need 2020 Sales Classic Pudsey Ears
  - Please always preface any BBC Children in Need payment items with 'BBC Children in Need 2020 Sales'.
  - 1 x Pudsey Ears costs £2.50.
  - The payer must pay the fixed amount.

#### How to create a New Payment Item:

In ParentPay, navigate to **Payment Items** and **follow these instructions**:

- 1. Select Create Payment Item
- 2. Select the **Activity** category & click **Next**
- 3. Select Repeatable Fixed Amount With Quantity
- 4. Click Next

Please complete the required fields for the type of payment item you are setting up. To help you with this, please see a list of fields and specific information you should be inputting next.





Item Name	Make sure your payment item name is relevant and clear. It will be visible to parents and in all of your reports.	ll

	The description enables you to provide detailed information to payers about the payment item. You can include hyperlinks to relevant websites to provide further information if you want to	
Description	Here's a suggested BBC Children in Need description:  "We are proud to be raising money for BBC Children in Need. If you would like to make a contribution, your generosity really w be used to help change the lives of disadvantaged children and young people. Thank you."	ill
Notes	This field is optional. If you choose to include a mandatory notes field, the payer cannot continue to payment until they have filled in this field. Ensure to specify any required information in your description.	on
Due Date	This field is optional. Input a payment due date for payers here	1
Use Due Date	Tick this box if you want the payer to see the due date.	
Quantity	Please don't use this field.	
Limited Availability	Please don't use this field.	
Costs Default Minimum/Maximum	The default amount that will appear in the payer account agains the payment item. As the payment item is a fixed amount the default amount will be the same as the minimum and maximum amount.	
Consent	Tick this box if you require payer consent when making a payment. It is up to your school if you wish to use it.	
Allow New Item Alert	Tick this box if you want to send automated text or email alerts to payers that have opted in to receive alerts about new payme items assigned to their child.	
PayPoint Enabled	Tick this box to be able to generate barcoded letters for this payment item.	






You will then need to select the relevant bank account you want to credit payment to for the new payment item. It should look something like this:



The system also allows you to use six different reporting codes. You can enter these in the **Account Code** and **Description** boxes or you can select from the pre-populated drop-down menus. The reporting codes will be included in your reports and settlement statements

#### Please note: Use Account Code 'BBC Children in Need 2020'



#### How to assign relevant people to a New Payment Item:

- 1. Click Save Payment Item to create your new payment item.
- 2. Scroll to the bottom of the saved details and select **Assign People**.
- 3. Select your filters from the dropdown menus and select **Search**.
- 4. Assign your pupils to the item by populating the **Add** column. To assign every pupil in the list, select **Add** in the heading.
- 5. Click Save Settings.
